

Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are 4 sizes of hook type tine carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type blade carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type forks may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades could vary by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
